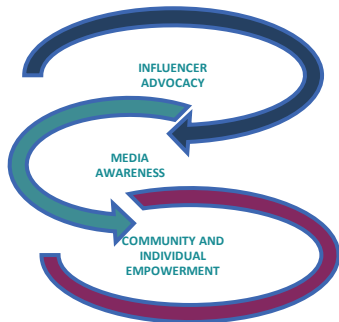




## Community Mobiliser through SASA! Together Approach | Terms of Reference

UNFPA & Ifrah Foundation support a combined approach to the elimination of FGM/C in the form of three pillars of action in the areas of Advocacy, Awareness and Community Empowerment.



**Advocacy:** Obtaining buy-in and pledges from key influencers and decision makers i.e. Political & Religious Leaders

**Media Awareness:** Major media initiatives intended to amplify communication on elimination of FGM and amplifying Advocacy and Community Empowerment efforts.

**Community Empowerment:** Engagement with

individuals, communities and Community Organisations, education, training & health providers who reach individual practitioners, parents & guardians.

The SASA! Together programme will play a central role in the community empowerment arm of this campaign. We now wish to engage **5 Community Mobiliser** (3 female and 2 male) to implement this programme with 3 positions **Dharkenley, Banadir** and 2 positions in **Jowhar, Shabelle**.

### This role will:

- Raise awareness on GBV/FGM prevention through SASA! Together methodology
- Train, coach, mentor and support community activists and leaders
- Conduct regular individual, community and institutional level GBV/FGM prevention sessions through SASA! Together methodology
- Facilitate and organize community level workshop, seminars & campaigns
- Arrange and conduct GBV/FGM prevention training to engage community leaders, men & boys
- Facilitate and organize community level public events on important dates like 16 days of activism, International Women's Day
- Work in close partnership with other NGO/INGO and government
- Prepare weekly and monthly community mobilization activity plan and report using SASA! Together Learning and assessment tools.
- Ensure all SASA! Together materials are used for intended purpose at right time and place.



**The idea candidate will:**

- Have previous experience on gender/GBV/FGM.
- Community facilitation and mobilisation experience is desirable.
- Be fluent in the Somali language.
- Demonstrate an ability to work in a busy environment, juggling multiple priorities simultaneously.
- Understanding of, and commitment to promoting gender equality and human rights.
- Have at least 2 years' experience working in this area.
- Be highly motivated with an ability to work alone and as part of a team.
